Luke 17:1-10

Sin, Faith, Duty

¹ Jesus said to his disciples: "Things that cause people to stumble are bound to come, but woe to anyone through whom they come.

² It would be better for them to be thrown into the sea with a millstone tied around their neck than to cause one of these little ones to stumble.

³ So watch yourselves. "If your brother or sister sins against you, rebuke them; and if they repent, forgive them.

⁴ Even if they sin against you seven times in a day and seven times come back to you saying 'I repent,' you must forgive them."

⁵ The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!"

⁶ He replied, "If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will obey you.

⁷ "Suppose one of you has a servant plowing or looking after the sheep. Will he say to the servant when he comes in from the field, 'Come along now and sit down to eat'?
